Necker Pass Challenge

We would like to produce a necker pass challenge video.

This is a string of clips edited together showing our tangerine necker being passed from one member to another. The video will include Beavers, Cubs, Scouts and Leaders. If you live in the same house as another member you could pass the necker on in one clip and do something together.

A guide for this to work:

- Ask your adult to film you and email or WhatsApp the clip to a leader with written consent so we can use publicly.
- Use a 4th Heswall tangerine necker.
- The necker must come into shot from your right, and exit to your left, so the necker travels from left to right on the screen.
- We would like you to wear full uniform, fancy dress or scouting related attire such as a hoody.
- Make the clip interesting, inventive, amusing and short.
- Preferably filmed in the daytime.
- Finally, and perhaps most importantly SMILE

If you haven’t got a necker, don’t miss out, please ask your adult to contact me.

CHEF ACTIVITY BADGE



The perfect badge to try at home and one that your adults may, or may not appreciate. Demonstrate to them you can achieve all the goals below, record your evidence, get your badge.

A summary of how to earn your badge:

1. Plan a menu for a weekend event for between four and six people.
2. Show how and where to shop for the food, this could be online.
3. Show how to store food properly.
4. Cook and serve at least one of the meals from your menu.
5. Demonstrate the best way to clear up afterwards.

Take photos or video clips as evidence, ask your adult to make a vlog or write a review of your meal.
