A circular economy is based on the principles of designing out waste and pollution, keeping products and materials in use, and regenerating natural systems.

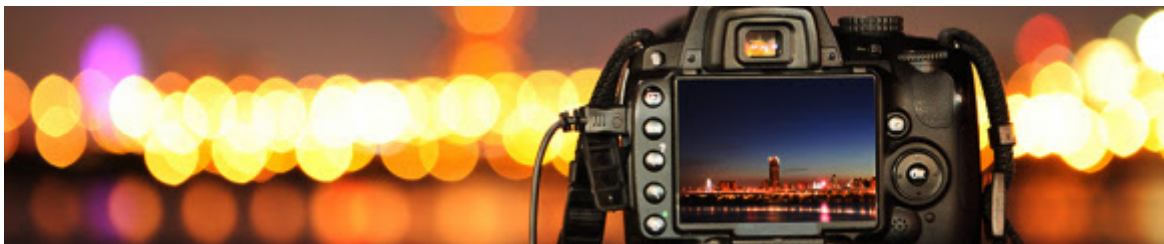
